Ralph Wilson, Jr.

Ralph Wilson, Jr., an educator with the Midwest AIDS Prevention Project, died Sunday, May 9 in an automobile accident in Huntington Woods.

A resident of Grand Blanc, Mr. Wilson, 28, graduated from the University of Michigan in 1989.

He was born in South Carolina, and moved to Michigan in 1986. While attending college, Mr. Wilson worked part-time for WEYI-TV in Clio and WFBE-FM in Flint. He joined MAPP in October, 1991 where he provided AIDS prevention programs to a wide variety of community groups throughout Michigan. He had a special relationship with young people, and provided many education programs for teenagers at middle schools, high schools, colleges, and concerts.

Mr. Wilson is survived by his father and mother, Ralph and Dorothy Wilson of Columbus, Georgia, sisters Tricia and Lauris, brothers Gregory and John, and aunt Carrie Holmes, with whom he lived in Grand Blanc.

The funeral was held in Columbus, Georgia on Saturday, May 15. A memorial service for Michigan friends was held Friday, June 4 at the Full Truth Fellowship Church in Detroit. ▼
